

# What happens if I don't choose a health care agent?

Oregon State law lists who will make health care decisions for you if you cannot

## The order for who will decide is:



A guardian appointed by the state



Named **health care representative** with health care decision-making authority in the advance directive



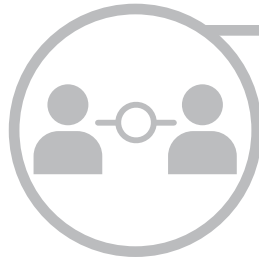
Your **spouse** or **registered domestic partner** (even if separated)



An **adult designated by others on this list**, without objection by anyone on list



Your **adult children** \*



Your **parent**



Your **adult siblings** \*



Your **adult relative or close friend**



**Att. Physician** (includes naturopathic physicians)

**\*Adult Children & Siblings: majority rule. Judicial recourse not addressed**



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
