## Primary Care

A condition that requires care, and your doctor's office is open.\*



## Urgent Care

A condition that requires immediate care, but is not life-threatening.



## Emergency Care

A condition that is life- or limb-threatening.



Regular health screenings

Check-ups

If something causes you concern

Fever

Cough or colds

Unexplained weight changes

Lingering pain

Common sprain

Earache

Cold and flu

Abdominal pain

Sore throat

Minor cuts requiring stitches

Minor burns

Urinary tract infection

Asthma attacks

Rash without fever

Chest pain

Loss of consciousness

Head and eye injuries

Severe bleeding

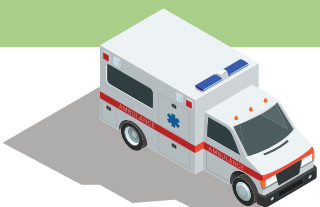
Difficulty breathing

Sudden loss of vision or blurred vision

Rash with fever

Major fracture

\* Primary care is an option for most urgent care conditions except asthma attacks and minor cuts requiring stitches.
