What happens if I don't choose a health care agent?

Oregon State law lists who will make health care decisions for you if you cannot.

The order for who will decide is:

*Adult Children & Siblings: majority rule. Judicial recourse not addressed.

A guardian appointed by the state

Named **health care representative** with health care decision-making authority in the advance directive

Your spouse

An adult designated by others on this list, without objection by anyone on list

Your adult children *

Either of your parents

Your adult siblings *

Your adult relative or close friend
