TN Visa Application

Apply for TN visa using PeaceHealth prepared application at U.S./Canada border Port of Entry, or at the Preclearance Office of the Dept. of Homeland Security at the airport in Canada.

Social Security

Go in-person to the nearest Social Security Office to apply for a Social Security Number.

I-94 Admission

Enter the U.S. and look up your I-94 admission record [here](#).
