What ADHD really is

Attention Deficit
Hyperactivity Disorder

Types:

- ADHD inattentive
- Hyperactive impulsive
- Combined type

Myths: lazy, unfocused, try harder, boys-only, outgrow




Before making an ADHD appointment

- Talk with your family physician
- Consult your child's <u>teacher</u>
- <u>Document</u> symptoms & behaviors
- Consider other causes & conditions



Testing and Other Diagnoses


- Comprehensive evaluation of ADHD may include interviews with the child, parents, teachers and other caregivers
- Interview will include a thorough history of the individual's core symptoms
- Parent(s) and child will be asked to complete ADHD behavior and self-report rating scale
- Teachers, day care providers, baby-sitters may be asked to complete relevant rating scales
- Observe child (patient) in school and other natural environments
- Review relevant school and medical records
- Complete a bio-psycho-social assessment

Managing Medication

Psychostimulants

Subgroups

- Methylphenidate (Ritalin, Concerta, Focalin)
- Amphetamine (Adderall, Dexedrine, Vyvanse)

Effects

- Motor
- Cognitive
- Social

Risks and side effects



Nonstimulant Medications

- Atomoxetine (Strattera)
- Alfa adrenergic agents
- Antidepressants

Alternative treatments

- Omega 3 acids
- Dietary treatments

Starting & monitoring medication


