In 2016, the community celebrated the hospital’s 80th anniversary of serving Lane County. PeaceHealth Sacred Heart at University District had been the largest hospital in the area until PeaceHealth Sacred Heart at RiverBend opened in 2008. With most services moved to the larger hospital, University District is now a specialty services hospital with an emergency department, the Oregon Rehabilitation Center and behavioral health services.
