The healthcare needs of Lane County and western Oregon are changing. We're meeting those needs by improving access to care through additional services, new equipment and facilities and re-imagining our current processes — all to provide you with a better patient experience.

## \$25M Sacred Heart at RiverBend Emergency Department growth and investment

We're expanding our Emergency Department to shorten wait times and improve capacity. Emergency visits have **grown from 55,000 in FY2024 to nearly 80,000 visits today**. To meet the demand, we have added:



**20 new** care spaces



**27 new** nursing positions



**205 additional** caregiver hours per day



**8 new** observation unit beds



**Starting a \$6M** ED renovation project

### New Inpatient Rehab Facility

PeaceHealth is **investing \$76M** to build a new inpatient rehab facility in partnership with Lifepoint Health.

PeaceHealth is **investing \$82M** to build Timber Springs Behavioral Health Hospital.

## Community support

- **\$165,177** awarded to **six safety-focused community outreach projects** from PeaceHealth Sacred Heart Medical Center Foundation
- Sponsored the **Willamalane Fitness Center**, making fitness more accessible and inclusive for all

## RiverBend and area clinic improvements

- **19 new patient beds** on the 8th floor — plus 31 more when the rehab unit relocates
- Opened **Pediatrics Plus Clinic** at Valley River Center, the area's first and only pediatrics-focused urgent care
- New **CT scanner** and remodeled CT suite at Cottage Grove, expanding imaging services locally
- Expanded **Ear, Nose & Throat services** — including surgeries and pediatric care — at Peace Harbor
- **6 clinicians** at Oregon Lung Specialist joined PeaceHealth to open the Pulmonary and Sleep Medicine at Chad Drive clinic
