

Know where to go for care

Remember, if you have a medical emergency, go to your nearest emergency room or call 911.



Primary care

Need care within days or weeks

For concerns that need attention but aren't urgent. Examples include:

- Chronic conditions
- Medication review
- Yearly check-ups and screenings



Emergency care

Need care within minutes or hours

For severe or life-threatening conditions that need attention right away. Examples include:

- Heart attack or stroke symptoms
- Major injuries
- Severe bleeding

Call 9-1-1 for help.



Priority Care*

Need care today

For minor illnesses or injuries that will not get better on their own or that may get worse if you wait. Examples include:

- Cuts or sprains
- Infections
- Vomiting and diarrhea

**May also be known as Urgent Care in some areas.*
