



Contraception

PeaceHealth does not promote contraception, permanent or temporary. It recognizes, however, that medically indicated exceptions are necessary for the wellbeing of persons and to enable PeaceHealth to contribute to the health of the communities in which we serve.

PeaceHealth requires that natural family planning information be available in the settings where PeaceHealth providers serve. Moreover, it is the obligation of PeaceHealth to develop procedures which protect and foster the values of informed consent, freedom of conscience, and the privacy of the doctor-patient relationship. Each facility evaluates contraceptive services the same as other services to insure that patients are receiving quality care.
