Are PeaceHealth employees covered by any unions?

Though many positions are not part of a union or a Collective Bargaining Agreement (CBA), some PeaceHealth positions are. Employees in positions covered by a CBA may be required to join and pay required dues.

Why does PeaceHealth use an all online application system?

PeaceHealth uses an online application system to better manage the application and hiring process. We receive a large volume of applications and want to give each candidate the attention and consideration they deserve. By filling out the application online, it is immediately entered into our database making it searchable by all of our recruiters and available for review. This online database allows you to set up your own personal profile you can visit as often as you like to update information or apply for additional jobs without having to complete a new application each time.

Can I apply from my mobile device?

You can browse open positions and apply from your mobile device.

What employment opportunities are currently available at PeaceHealth?

All open positions are posted at our [Career Site](#).

What should I do if I don't have an e-mail address?

You can create an e-mail address free of charge at a variety of email hosting websites. (For example: gmail.com.)

Can I be informed about future opportunities?

You can create a [Job Agent/Alert](#), which save your job preferences using keywords and location. You can also select how often you would like to receive these email notifications. When positions you may be interested in are posted, you will receive an email notification. You can have multiple Job Agents/Alerts based on your preferences. These e-mails are automated and are sent directly to the email you have provided.

**** Please note: If you receive a Job Agent/Alert notification, you must still submit an application for that position to be considered as a candidate.

How do I stop receiving Job Agent/Alert emails?

The next time you receive a Job Agent/Alert email click on the provided link to stop the service.

How long are the job postings generally on the Career Site?

A position remains on our Careers Site until we have a sufficient applicant pool, or until the position is filled/cancelled.

What if a position I am interested in is not found on the Career Site? Can I submit an application anyway?

A position remains on our Career Site until we have a sufficient applicant pool, or until the position is filled/cancelled. To be considered for a position, an application must be successfully submitted.

I am a current PeaceHealth Caregiver, how to I apply?

Current employees must log on to the PeaceHealth network to apply as an INTERNAL applicant. Failure to successfully log in with your 3x3 and password before applying will result in your being viewed as an EXTERNAL applicant.

Do I need to add a resume and cover letter to my application?

In order to be considered for a position at PeaceHealth applicants must only complete the online application. The ability to add a resume and/or a cover letter is an optional feature but strongly recommended.

How do I upload my resume and cover letter into my application?

I'd like to include a cover letter with my application addressed to the appropriate individual. How can I find out their name?

All applications are received in a central database. It is not necessary to address a cover letter to a specific individual.

How do I know if you received my application?

You will receive a confirmation e-mail to the address you provided in your Candidate Profile. You can also log back into your [Candidate Profile](#) and check your [application status](#).

How do I log back in?

I forgot my password. How do I reset it?

Just return to the [PeaceHealth Careers](#) page and click on *Create/View Profile* in the upper right corner for assistance with forgotten passwords.

What can I view once I log into my Candidate Profile?

In your candidate profile, you have the ability to:

- Apply for positions
- Edit your contact information and previously submitted applications
- Update your e-mail address
- Change your password
- Edit/Update your candidate profile, resume, and/or cover letter
- View all of the jobs you have applied to and see the status of each application in the Job Management tab
- Withdraw your application(s)

Once you apply for a position you can expect to receive an email notification of any status change. A member of the Talent Acquisition team may also reach out to you directly.
